Preparation: Protein-A/G purified

Solvent: 0.01 M phosphate buffer, pH 7.4, containing 0.5 M NaCl and 15 mM sodium azide

Storage: In the dark at 4-8°C

ANTIGEN

Polio (acute poliomyelitis, infantile paralysis) is caused by the poliovirus, which may infect the nervous system and cause lasting paralysis. Poliovirus is a single-stranded RNA virus and a member of the Picornavirus family. There are three separate types of the virus: Type 1, Type 2 and Type 3.

IMMUNOGEN

Polio virus type 1 (inactivated)

SPECIFICITY

HYB 295-15 is specific for poliovirus type 1. There is no cross-reactivity with poliovirus type 2 and 3.

EPI TOPE SPECIFICITY

REACTIVITY

HYB 295-15 reacts with poliovirus type 1. In ELISA HYB 295-15 can be used both as catching antibody and detection antibody.
